**MEETINGS NAME BADGES** received at registration must be worn when attending all conference sessions.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS** Only announcements that apply to the entire delegation will be made at general sessions. Chapter announcements must be made at the designated chapter meetings.

**AND REMEMBER** Meeting attendees may not purchase, possess, consume or be under the influence of illegal drugs, tobacco or alcohol at any time. Violators will be subject to stringent disciplinary action. Be considerate of sleeping hours and the privacy of other hotel guests and FCCLA members. Please follow the curfews as outlined in the program. The adviser in charge of the chapter is responsible for the behavior and safety of the members. Inappropriate behavior may result in delegates being sent home at their own expense. Please be considerate of all hotel guests when using the elevators and facilities. Check your room carefully before departure. Please clean your room of all excess garbage. Be sure all personal belongings have been removed.
